- IS ELAINE PHILLIPS YOUR STATE SENATOR? YOUR 5-MINUTE CALL COULD MAKE OR BREAK TRANSGENDER RIGHTS IN NEW YORK STATE! The NYS transgender civil rights bill (GENDA, the Gender Expression Non-Discrimination Act) is headed to the Investigations and Government Operations Committee of the New York State Senate for a vote in the next week or two. If this bill does not pass this committee, IT IS DEAD FOR 2018. PERIOD. The committee is made up of 4 Democrats and 5 Republicans (INCLUDING ELAINE PHILLIPS). If they vote along party lines, GENDA will be stalled in the Senate after passing in the House, for the 16th year in a row. That means yet another year of discrimination in employment, housing and public services.

Senator Phillips has made it clear that she supports rights for all, but she is not very aware of the transgender and non-binary community, and still has many questions. If enough of us call Senator Phillips, she might react positively to these actions and vote to move GENDA to the next committee. This act alone would be historical, as the bill has never passed a committee and moved to the next level of approval! Do you have FIVE MINUTES TO MAKE HISTORY??

Here's a sample script you can use when you call: "I am a constituent of Senator Phillips. I live at: (Street address and town). I want the Senator to know that transgender people deserve to

have their civil rights. I urge the Senator to vote for the Gender Expression Non-Discrimination Act, Senate Bill Number 7010 when she votes in the Senate Investigations and Government Operations Committee."
